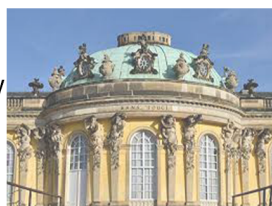


## Monday, 13 June 2022 - Centre Marc Bloch, Berlin

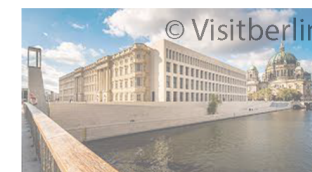
